Cassidy is our beautiful 16 year old daughter who tragically lost her life to suicide December 20, 2015. Cassidy was the happiest, funniest, most free-spirited person you would ever meet. She enjoyed life to the fullest... she was fearless! She was goofy, she was a cheerleader, she would bring laughter to the room, she loved the outdoors, and she had a huge heart for all animals. Cassidy was a loyal friend and a loving daughter. She had incredible friends and a supporting family who loved her unconditionally. Cassidy had her whole world ahead of her ... yet she fell victim to suicide.

Cassidy didn't fit the typical mold you would expect from a victim of suicide. She wasn't depressed, she wasn't bullied, she wasn't unhappy. She loved her friends and she loved life! She had no past history of depression and she showed no warning signs before choosing to end her life that day. This devastation came as a horrific shock to our family. Cassidy did not reach out to anyone for help before choosing to end her life that Monday ... she kept silent.





Cassidy Joined for Hope, Inc. is a national 501(C)(3) non-profit foundation focused on teen suicide prevention in the schools and community. We recognize that teen suicides are not isolated instances ... but the second leading cause of death for ages 10-24. No community or family is immune.

OUR MISSION

The mission of the Cassidy Joined for Hope Foundation is to PREVENT TEEN SUICIDE. We provide resources, support, training and education to schools and communities in spreading awareness of suicide prevention.

We partner with other organizations within our mission to offer resources and events to our community. This includes speaking events, suicide prevention training, sponsorships for therapy, support groups, suicide prevention PSA's, and provide funding the Joined for Hope clubs in the schools.

Suicide is preventable, and our vision is to be a suicide-free community. This must be a community-wide movement, starting with our children, our schools and homes.
